

Course Equivalency

- Courses listed fulfill general education or elective requirements in bachelor completion programs at ACE.
- Courses with a NCCRS recommendation will fall into the “Nontraditional American Council on Education and National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCCRS) approved select non-credit course, program, or certificate offered by an organization,” which has a maximum credit transfer of 60 credits for bachelor completion programs.
- Courses not listed in the grid can be considered if maximum number of transferred credits has not been reached, to fulfill elective requirements.

*HRM4003 is an ACE core course in the B.S. in Business Administration & Leadership program which means this would go as transfer credit beyond general education.
